**ORDER AUTHORIZING SALE OF PROPERTY OF ESTATE

Robert Yaquinto, Jr., Trustee, notified all parties in interest on April 9, 2004, of Trustee's Motion to Sell Property of Estate Free and Clear of Liens and notified all parties on April 21, 2004, of Trustee's Amended Motion to Sell Property of Estate Free and Clear of Liens and Encumbrances with any liens or encumbrances to attach to the proceeds of the sale. The Court, having considered the motion and amended motion and no objections to the sale having been timely filed and served upon the Trustee, finds that the estate will be best served by selling the property of the estate. **ORDERED** that Robert Yaquinto, Jr., Trustee, is authorized to sell to Central Valley Software Solutions, LLC ("CVSS") all of the estate's interest in that property described in that

The sale shall be free and clear of liens and encumbrances with any liens or encumbrances to attach to the proceeds of the sale. It is further

**ORDERED** that Robert Yaquinto, Jr., Trustee, is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the sale and transfer of the property. It is further

**ORDERED** that the stay provided pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 6004(g) shall not apply, and this order is effective immediately upon entry by the Clerk.
